Air Sailing Hangar & Tie Down Memorandum

TO: Air Sailing Recreational Vehicle (RV) Owners
FROM: David Volkmann, Hangar & Tie Down Manager
RE: RV Park Spring 2010 Opening
DATE: Tuesday, March 09, 2010

The Air Sailing Gliderport RV Park will be open for arrivals on Wednesday, March 31, 2010. In order to comply with County regulations that RV storage is not allowed and that only *occupied* trailers are permitted (limited to 60 contiguous days), **I request that all returning RVs be placed in their assigned locations in the RV Park as late in the soaring season as possible - perhaps in conjunction with your first soaring excursion? – and that RVs be removed from ASI property for a period of at least 24 hours every 60 days.** Furthermore, we request that all returning RVs be removed from the RV Park as early after the soaring season as possible. We anticipate closing the RV Park again next winter. Please complete and return the attached rental agreement to me prior to placing your RV in its assigned location in the RV Park.

Also please recall that electrical hookups to outlets are prohibited and that solar battery chargers are commercially available for your electrical needs.

The Trustees of Air Sailing and I know the County's non-storage and 60-day requirements are a big pain, but the County is simply not willing to compromise on these issues. We have no idea of how rigorously the County will monitor compliance with the 60-day rule itself, but at this point we think it is essential to make a good faith effort to do everything feasible to adhere to the 60-day rule and other conditions of the RV Park Special Use Permit. We believe that ignoring the 60-day rule will ultimately endanger our ability to offer campground space for RVs.
